Call to order: The APRN Committee meeting was called to order by Patsy Zeller, MSN, APRN, FNP, Chair, at 2:03 p.m. by Zoom virtual meeting.

P. Zeller stated because the APRN Committee is conducting this public meeting by Zoom, she stated for the record the following information:

Unfinished Business:

2022 APRN Legislation Amy Siple, KAPN reported on pending APRN Legislation Senate Substitute House Bill 2279. The House Bill passed the Senate, and the House Bill was then moved to the House. Very hopeful that the House Bill will pass. The House Bill if pass will not go into effect until July 1, 2023.

CNM-I Regulations: C. Moreland reported on the CNM-I Regulations. The Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (BOHA) has no new proposed regulations. BOHA is still trying to get four previous proposed regulations that both BOHA and KSBN agreed on through the process. BOHA will hold a Public Hearing on the four proposed regulations on June 8, 2022.

PMP Committee Report: S. Gregg reported on the PMP Committee Report. Shannon reported that KTRACS Senate Bill 200 regarding the Pharmacists Scope of Practice was in Conference Committee. Upon the Conference Committee Report and adoption from both Senate and House. The KTRACTS Senate Bill 200 will pass.

APRN Program Approvals: C. Moreland gave a report on license applicants from out of state APRN Programs that met the national accreditation standards and have been licensed since the APRN Committee met on December 14, 2021.
